

Water damage can come from many sources. Whether it's a toilet overflow, a failed water heater, or a storm, water can cause significant damage to homes and businesses alike. Removing the water as soon as possible is the most effective way to minimize damage. Mold can start to grow 24 - 48 hours after becoming damp, so immediate moisture removal is critical. Our IICRC certified technicians will use specially designed, highly efficient equipment to dry affected areas and materials quickly and effectively. Once dry, we will restore your property to pre-loss condition.




Water Damage Restoration

Discovering water damage can feel devastating and can be a serious problem if not dealt with properly. In addition to causing damage, water can also spread contaminants that may lead to disease. A quick response to water intrusion is imperative due to the invasive properties of moisture:

- Within minutes, moisture-sensitive surfaces swell and disfigure. Paper goods (books, documents, pictures) can be ruined and stains from furniture start to appear on carpeting, which can be permanent.
- Within hours, drywall softens and warps, and wooden furniture can be permanently damaged. If carpet becomes delaminated (the primary backing separates from the secondary backing), it can cause serious damage.
- Within days, fungi and bacteria begin to grow and spread. Foul odors start to permeate your property.

HRS's IICRC certified clean-up crews are composed of expert technicians - including **Master Water Restorers** - who will ensure you receive the highest quality water removal and water clean-up services. Once the cause of the water emergency is mitigated and clean-up has been completed, our construction team can provide the building services you need such as drywall, painting, flooring, electrical, and plumbing to return your facility to its original state.







Fire damage is devastating in so many ways. Our professional fire damage restorers are available 24/7/365 and will be there quickly to secure the property, boarding up any doors and windows and tarping any roof openings, including those created by emergency personnel. Our team will remove all debris, clean-up water, disinfect and deodorize, and rebuild the damaged structure quickly and professionally, working with your insurance adjuster to restore your home or business.









Fire Damage Restoration

A fire can be the most traumatic and devastating experience a home or business owner ever faces. In a best case scenario, it can cause minor smoke damage; in a worst case scenario, it can obliterate an entire structure. HRS will help you navigate these stressful circumstances and bring your home or building back to a safely useable state.

By carefully following our proven procedures, we ensure your property is brought back to the safe, comfortable space that existed before the fire and smoke damage. This begins with a property inspection to assess the level of structural damage and content damage. We will report our findings to you and answer any questions you may have so you are fully informed and understand what results can be reasonably expected.

In simple terms, returning your facility to its pre-fire state consists of four general elements: structural damage restoration, content restoration and/or removal, smoke mitigation, and odor mitigation. Making sure your building is structurally sound is a priority. If there are stability issues, our professional restoration team can provide full construction services to rectify the situation. We will also remove any furniture, fixtures, or equipment that has been burned beyond repair, including items containing synthetic materials. Any items that are salvageable will be repaired and returned both to minimize cost and help ease the anxiety of loss; unsafe items will be disposed of. Finally, our disaster clean-up team will remove all smoke residue, including the pervasive odor. Our IICRC certified Odor Control Technicians will use odor removal techniques include thermal fogging, high-level ozone deodorization, and hydroxyl deodorization.



Mold can pose a serious health hazard and remediation requires a thorough understanding of the risks involved, making it important to have removal performed by trained and licensed professionals that understand the proper safety procedures. Effective mold removal starts with moisture mitigation, first determining moisture levels, then drying with dehumidifiers and air movers with HEPA filters. Once dry, our team removes the mold spores and disinfects the surfaces to prevent future mold growth.



Mold Restoration

Mold occurs in damp areas and is often caused by water damage or flooding. Mold can also be the result of a current water leak or improper water leak clean-up from a previous issue.

Mold can be present in carpet, wall interiors, floorboards, and ceilings, as well as easily spotted locations. Depending on the extent of the mold, a property can even be declared uninhabitable due to the threat it poses to the health of the occupants. No homeowner or business owner wants to hear that they have mold. Mold spreads quickly and can cause severe respiratory problems, especially in infants, children, the elderly, and those with health issues.

Once mold has been detected, our team inspects your space to determine exactly where the mold is growing and how moisture is coming into your property. The information we gather focuses our efforts on where they are needed most. We begin by drying the moisture that is allowing the mold to thrive, then cleaning and disinfecting all affected surfaces to prevent the mold from growing back. Once the mold is stopped and all affected surfaces are cleaned, restoration begins. Our licensed contractors work to return your property to its pre-mold condition by repairing anything that was affected — on the interior or exterior of your home. The mold removal and restoration process can take as little as a few days or as long as a few weeks.







Traumatic events such as a crime occurrence or unattended death can be overwhelming for everyone involved. We understand how difficult this is and will deliver compassionate assistance in restoring order to your home or business. Trauma/bio-hazard cleanup should not be attempted by anyone who is not specifically trained for forensic cleaning. You can be confident that any area we've cleaned is free from bio-hazardous material and safe to use.



Trauma clean-up and bio-cleaning is not a subject people give much thought to until they need the service. When dealing with a crime scene at your facility, or with the aftermath of a fatality, the emotional toll can be overwhelming. HRS professionals can help ease the burden of the situation by eliminating all trace of the death or incident. This includes removing unsafe items and substances such as blood, other bodily fluids, and filth, all of which can contain biological hazards. Sanitizing a trauma situation involves eradicating microscopic particulates such as bacteria and viruses to ensure a clean and healthy space. HRS Restoration Services follows IIRC s540 standards, providing the highest industry standard of trauma and crime scene clean-up. Our highly trained technicians will decontaminate your property, working in coordination with fire departments and police to help you through this process as efficiently and quickly as possible.

Our bio-cleaning professionals also specialize in remediating hoarding situations. Hoarding can be dangerous because it can put those in the vicinity at risk of fire, poor sanitation, and even structural issues in their home or commercial property in extreme cases.

Asbestos is a known carcinogen and can be found in many different building materials including vinyl floor tile/mastic, pipe insulation, drywall compound, and popcorn ceilings, to name a few. If independent testing confirms the presence of asbestos, our certified professionals will create the proper containment and remove all hazardous materials per environmental regulations. Third party clearance testing will then ensure that the space is safe to reoccupy.

Asbestos Remediation

Most commonly found in homes and buildings constructed prior to 1980, asbestos can be found in numerous construction materials, including concrete, asphalt, roof shingles, pipes, siding, wall board, floor tiles, joint compounds, adhesive, and insulation. The hazardous nature of asbestos abatement calls for professional remediation to ensure safe removal and disposal. HRS will extract all asbestos from your facility to bring it back to a safely inhabitable space. Once the asbestos remediation is complete, our restoration team can rebuild the affected areas.



General Restoration & Repairs

Handling a home or commercial property's disaster situation requires both mitigating the issue and rebuilding the affected areas of the property. Once the emergency has been taken care of—whether it's water damage, fire damage, mold remediation, trauma clean-up/bio-cleaning, or asbestos abatement—the property will need to be restored. This could include structural repairs, drywall, plumbing, electrical, and/or landscape replacement just to name a few. As a fully licensed general contractor, we can provide these services to homeowners as well as commercial properties. Our work ranges from basic repairs to complex, multi-faceted projects.

Content Restoration

We then inventory all items to guarantee their safekeeping. Finally, we clean and deodorize all items. The final step includes returning items to your home or business, or keeping them preserved in storage until they can be returned safely.









- Work on behalf of the client to get them the best product and avoid having to come out of pocket.


Matterport Scanning



Steelwave The Link Denver, Colorado


HRS responded to a call for a water leak at The Link building in downtown Denver. A hose outside of the wash basin was left running over the weekend from Friday to Monday. All 12 floors were affected. Water mitigation (extraction, containment, air movement, and dehumidification) and select demolition were performed by HRS technicians. The project took 8 days to dry out sufficiently and remove drywall. Floor-to-floor insulation, drywall, and carpet were all affected in the flood.

Cripple Creek School District Modular Building

Cripple Creek, Colorado

HRS was called after a hailstorm damaged the Cripple Creek School District modular building. During the hailstorm, the windows leaked along with the roof. HRS' main scope of work was to replace the roof and install all new insulation and drywall. The project duration was several months due to getting the State permit. Sequentially, the roof had to be replaced before the interior work could begin.





Moon Valley Bible Church

Phoenix, Arizona

HRS received a call from the pastor at Moon Valley Bible Church after the roof collapsed and caved in, due to monsoon rains and insufficient roof drainage. The scope of work consisted of building dry out, asbestos mitigation, mold mitigation, structural repair, roofing repair, framing replacement, reinstallation of mechanical roof top units, electrical re-wire and panel replacement, low voltage wiring for stage and sound booth, insulation and drywall repairs, full interior re-paint, replacement of flooring throughout the entire building, stage and sound booth construction, and indoor playground disassembly and reassembly. This was an extremely complex reconstruction and restoration project with over \$2 million in repairs spanning approximately a 3-month timeframe.

University of Colorado Boulder Multiple Projects

Boulder, Colorado

Bear Creek Dorms

HRS was called when a sprinkler line popped, traveling down through three floors at the University of Colorado Boulder Bear Creek Dormitory. HRS utilized drying equipment and had to remove the ceilings on floors below the leak. All the walls needed to be dried out, as well as all the flooring.

955 Regent

HRS responded to a call at University of Colorado Boulder for a roof leak on campus at 955 Regent. The building was currently under construction and drywall had already been installed. The HRS technicians were tasked with removing the remaining Category 2 water and test all the walls for moisture. Due to the type of water and the fact that the walls hadn't been finished or painted, the drywall did not need to be replaced. HRS utilized state-ofthe-art thermal technology to detect where the water leaks occurred.







LadyLuck Casino

Black Hawk, Colorado

In the Fall of 2020 - HRS received a call from the LadyLuck Casino in Black Hawk, Colorado to repair damage to the main entrance canopy. The damage was the result of a forklift driver who had the forks fully extended when driving under the canopy, ultimately resulting in a large penetration / hole in the structure. HRS' restoration team was onsite that day to assess the damage and repair the canopy to ensure the safety of patrons and restore the aesthetics of the building to its original condition.
